MISSION:

At the heart of our mission is the commitment to reduce cat overpopulation through public awareness and spay/neuter efforts, and to improve the quality of life for stray and feral cats.

WHO WE ARE:

Colony Cats (& dogs) is a pioneering, 501(c)(3) nonprofit group that has provided specialized animal welfare services in central Ohio since 2002.

We were the first local group to offer a comprehensive program to aid feral cat caregivers with spay/ neuter, vaccinations, outdoor shelters, and supportive guidance.

WHAT WE DO:

- Facilitate low-cost and subsidized spay/neuter for domesticated, stray and feral cats.
- Educate regarding responsible pet ownership, offer advice to resolve animal behavioral issues, and suggest ways to keep pets in homes during financial crisis.
- Be a primary community source for caregivers of homeless strays and feral cats.
- Rescue animals from dire circumstances and give them veterinary and foster care until good adopters are found. Some of our cats and dogs come to us injured or abused. In 2009, Colony Cats Adoption Center was established to find more homes for domesticated stray cats.

AREA OF SERVICE:

- Colony Cats (& dogs) serves the central Ohio area.
- Since our group's inception, we have facilitated spay/neuter procedures for nearly 13,500 cats and dogs and placed more than 10,000 animals in homes.
- We have over 300 rescued animals in foster homes, at Colony Cats Adoption Center, and at adoption outreach locations.

BUDGET:

- Of our overall yearly expenses, spay/neuter and other veterinary care for homeless and rescued animals are approximately \$144,000.
- It costs \$31,200 annually to maintain Colony Cats Adoption Center (not including cat food and other supplies).
- · Revenue is generated through grants, fundraising events, individual contributions, in-kind donations, and adoption fees.
- In 2011, Colony Cats opened Kit & Kaboodle Boutique, a resale shop next to our cat adoption center, to help raise funds for our efforts.
- We operate thanks to the assistance of approximately 225 volunteers.
