I can't choose, I love cats and dogs equally!

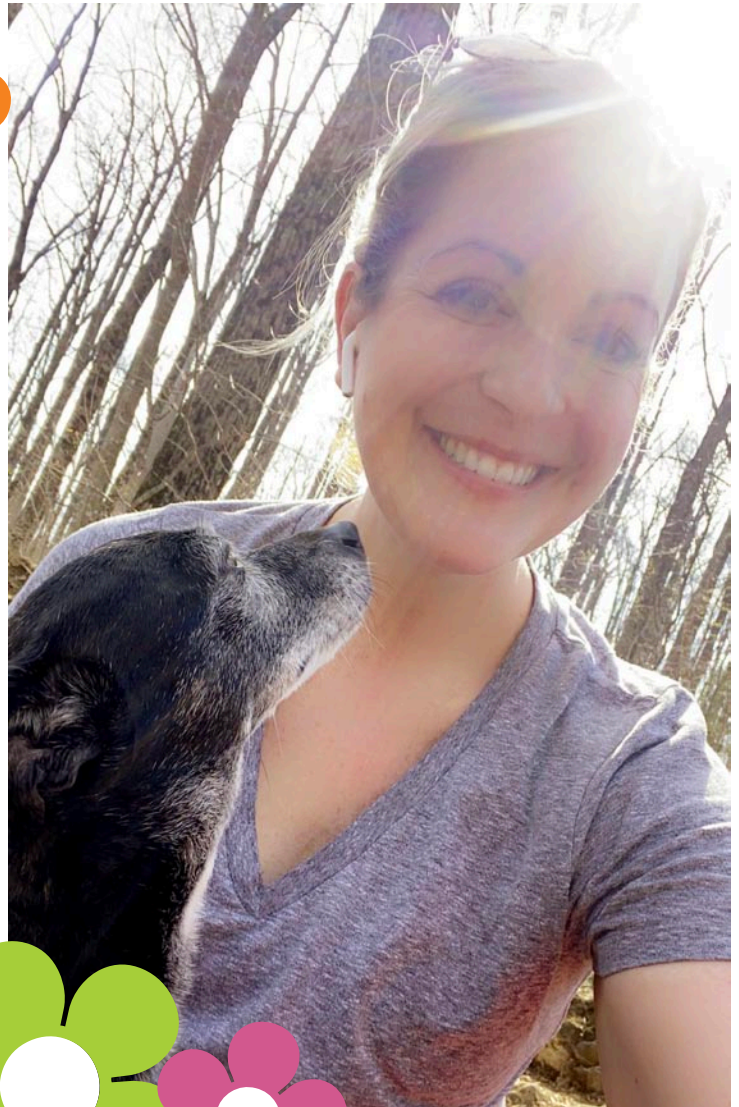
What's your advice to a new Colony Cats volunteer?
