Where you can find me when I'm not volunteering for Colony Cats:

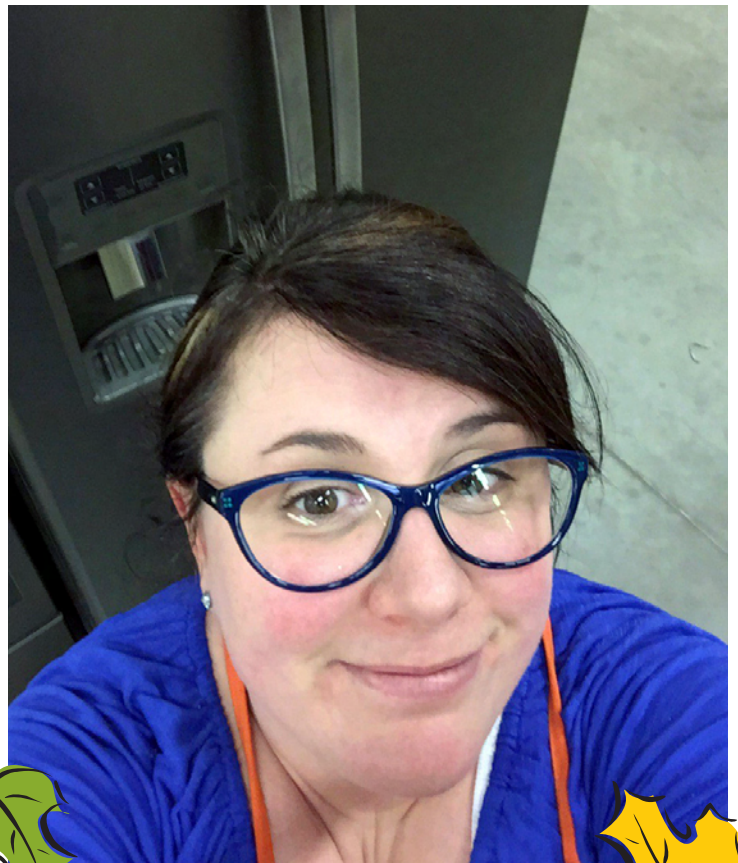
When I am not volunteering at Colony Cats Adoption Center I am either working at my full-time job, or working with my foster cats at home.
